

PRIVACY NOTICE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

1. The Purpose of the Privacy Notice and Position of Data Controller of the Women Self-Defence Association

This privacy notice was drafted by Women Self Defence Association which resident at Karaman mahallesi, Fulya sokak, No:1, Dolap:144, Nilüfer/Bursa, as data controller in accordance with Article 10 of the Turkish Law No. 6698 on the Protection of Personal Data ("**Law**") and the Communiqué on the Procedures and Principles of Fulfilling the Obligation to Inform .

2. The Purposes of Processing of Personal Data

Your personal data and sensitive personal data (name, surname, phone number, address, e-mail address, sex, photo, video and audio records) obtained by various means of recording including photos, videos and similar means, will be processed for the purpose of being the beneficiary of projects, events, campaigns, training and workshops carried out by the Women Self Defence Academy through various registration and questionnaire forms that will be used as part of the continuation of its activities carried out within the framework of the aims of the Women Self Defence Academy Association by taking required measures to protect their confidentiality based on the legal grounds that "*the processing is mandatory for the establishment, exercise or protection of any right*" as provided for by paragraph 2 of Article 5 of the Law.

3. Transfer of Personal Data

Your obtained personal data may be shared with third parties at home and/or abroad within the scope of the personal data processing conditions and purposes specified in Articles 8 and 9 of the Law for the purpose of the carrying out the necessary work and relevant business processes to benefit the relevant people from the operations provided by the Women Self-Defence Academy Association within the framework of its objectives including the planning and execution of the activities required to ensure the legal, technical and occupational safety of the relevant people in cooperation with whom the cooperation is made.

4. Method and Legal Reason for Collection of Personal Data

Personal data is obtained directly from real persons. The personal data collected is processed by the Women Self-Defence Academy Association either automatically or non-automatically. However, it is also possible for the Women Self-Defence Academy Association to access personal data through third parties and collect them automatically or non-automatically. Personal data obtained for the above-mentioned legal reasons may be processed and transmitted for the purposes specified in Articles 5 and 6 of

the Law and in this Privacy Notice and the Explicit Consent Form, where explicit consent is required.

5. **Your Rights as Data Subjects**

Data subjects have rights under Article 11 of the Law concerning the rights of the data subject in accordance with the Communiqué on the Procedures and Principles of Application to a Data Controller, which are;

- To learn whether your personal data have been processed or not,
- To request information as to processing if your data have been processed or not,
- To learn the purpose of processing of the personal data and whether data are used in accordance with their purpose or not,
- To know the third parties in the country or abroad to whom personal data have been transferred,
- To request rectification in case personal data are processed incompletely or inaccurately,
- To request deletion or destruction of personal data,
- To request notification with regards to the processes of correction, deletion and destruction to third parties to whom personal data have been transferred,
- To object to occurrence of any result that is to your detriment by means of analysis of personal data exclusively through automated systems,
